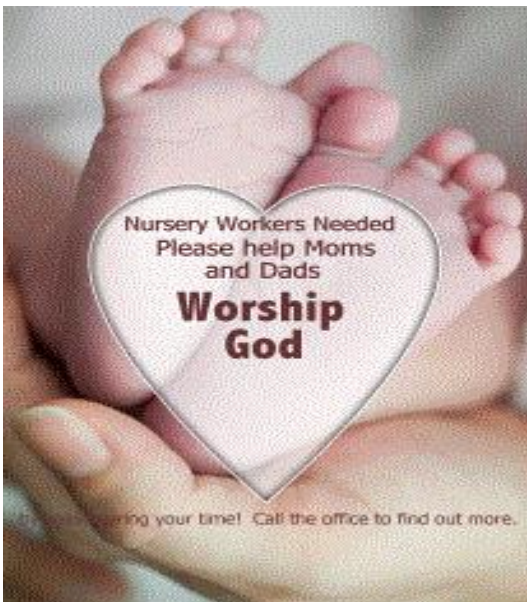

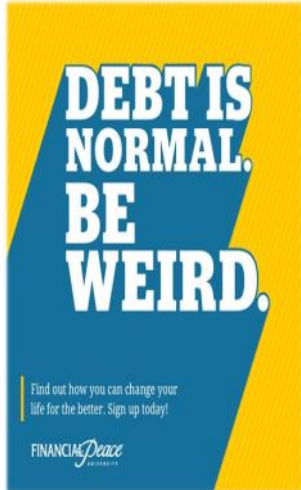

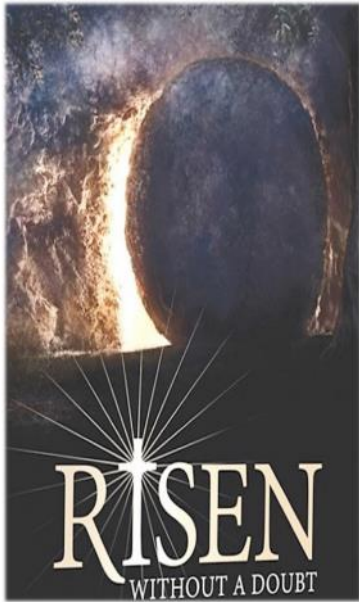

wisdom, n., the morally right application of knowledge.

If you could have anything, and I mean anything, what would you have? Imagine if God personally offered you anything you wanted.

This is exactly what a young Jewish man was offered by God. He could have asked for riches, fame, or power. But he didn't. He asked God for wisdom. He regarded wisdom as more valuable than any material or glorious gain he could achieve. Decades later he would write this belief down under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. He would

also go on to write some 3,000 proverbs, which partly articulated the wisdom he had received from God (1 Kings 4:32). Some of these proverbs were preserved in the Biblical book called Proverbs also called "The Thirty Sayings" (Prov. 22:20). These proverbs written nearly 3,000 years ago still speak volumes to us today and give us remarkable insight into how our lives can be enriching and satisfying.
