


Dear Friends and Family,

As many of you know Shawn Kelley went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, May 21, 2011. Shawn was serving faithfully as a missionary in Cameroon in Western Africa. Shawn's unexpected home going came after a brief and sudden illness, and though he was attended by physicians in two hospitals, he experienced respiratory failure which the doctors were unable to overcome. Shawn is much loved and much missed, but we know that though he is absent from us, he is present with the Lord. Our prayers and Christian sympathy are extended to his father Milton, his mother Paula, his brothers Troy and Todd, his nieces Stevie and Alexis, nephews Evan and Cameron and his extended family.



There will be a celebration of the life of Shawn Kelley on Sunday, June 5, 2011 at Falmouth Baptist Church, 60 Central Park Avenue, Falmouth, MA 02540, phone number 508-548-3260, website [www.falmouthbaptist.com](http://www.falmouthbaptist.com). The schedule is as follows: There will be a time of visitation with the Kelley family in the church sanctuary from 3 – 4:45 PM. After a brief respite for the family, a service will be held in the sanctuary from 5 – 6:15 PM. Immediately following the service there will be a time of gathering of fellowship in the Lower Fellowship Hall to which all are invited. The missionary community in Yaounde, Cameroon held a memorial service for Shawn on Sunday, May 22, 2011. Many spoke of Shawn's incredible servant's heart and the numerous ways he impacted many who are in missionary service as well as Cameroonian nationals. His service as a Field Administrator since March 2010 was of tremendous value for the body of Christ at large and serves as an inspiration to us all.

Shawn's gifts in helps, administration, and hospitality were invaluable to the missionary community. He excelled in the management of a multitude of administrative details which allowed church planters, Bible translators, and those involved in discipleship to serve even more effectively. Shawn was also responsible for overseeing the construction of a new dormitory (hostel) for missionary kids in the capital city of Yaounde at Rain Forest International School. We are praying for Shawn's missionary family, as well as the Cameroonian nationals who are mourning his loss. The Cameroonians have organized a processional in honor of Shawn to accompany his body as it is transported to the national airport in the coming days.
